COMPOSITION

An exciting competition for individual composers.

The competition is a major event, where composers have the opportunity of competing individually for the title of 'The North London Music Festival Composer of the Year 2012'. This competition comprises of three stages:

First Round

Composers submit a score and recording. A maximum of 7 competitors from three categories; junior, intermediate, and senior will be selected to enter the semi-final round.

Semi-Final Round

Selected composers will be invited to present a written commentary and performance of their piece to an audience and panel of professional judges. A special prize will be awarded to the most promising composer in this stage of the competition.

Final Round

A maximum of 5 semi-finalists will compete for the grand prize of £200 and the title of 'The North London Music Festival Composer of the Year 2012'. In addition, first prizes for the most outstanding junior, intermediate and senior compositions will each receive a Music Master Composition book written by Graham Bennett.
