<u>Instructions on how to use the manuscript templates:</u>

These templates are free to use, customise and print. Just follow the simple steps below to create your project ideas...

- Double click and open the pdf manuscript template. On your computer, select <u>File</u> from the toolbar menu, and click <u>Export</u> and then <u>Save</u> to move the interactive template to your desktop.
- Click on the various text boxes within the pdf to begin the process of creating your own project template.
- By deleting the content in each text box you will be able to remove these items from print. Only the text remaining on the page will appear on the printout.
- You can replace the text by deleting and typing in your own text. You can also position your new text by selecting the text box and using your computer spacebar.
- Remember to save each new, customised template with a different saver name. This will allow you to re-visit the same page and print as many copies as you require. To save, select <u>File</u> from your toolbar menu again, and click <u>Export as PDF</u>. You can then re-name your pdf template and then click <u>Save</u>. Remember, when using this command, your text will then become locked.
- We plan to add more manuscript templates with time.
